## Trades Foreperson (Re-announcement)

**Duties:** Under the direct supervision of the Drinking Water & Wastewater Division Manager or his/her designee. Serves as a Foreperson for multiple crews to include assigning and monitoring work and providing technical direction. Prepares daily schedules and submits for approval. Performs inspections of projects to ensure crews are performing quality work, following safety procedures, and following CUC policies. Performs inspections of projects and operations; provides troubleshooting of complex maintenance and operational problems; recommends and/or implements solutions. Ensures policies and procedures are adhered to, and that service quality and productivity levels are maintained. Oversees and performs journey level maintenance, installation, and/or operational activities in assigned service area; provides technical advice and guidance to staff. Performs inventory spot checks on tools, parts and materials; processes requisitions for necessary tools, parts and materials. Prepares and submits weekly and monthly reports. Provides technical advice and performs journey level operations, installations and/or repairs in service area assigned. Performs other duties of a similar nature or level as required.
