CUC provides the following responses to the Request for Information/Clarification (RFI/C):

1. IPP Qualification Requirements for International Bidders

Are there specific eligibility criteria or restrictions for international IPP proponents? Are foreign entities permitted to bid independently, or must they partner with a local entity?

CUC RESPONSE: There are no specific eligibility criteria or restrictions for international firms who wish to submit a proposal. Foreign entities are permitted to submit a proposal independently, without partnering with a local entity. However, please refer to page 21 of 31 of the Scope of Work: Section 6.1 Responsibilities of Parties: “[P]roponents should be aware that a current CNMI Business License is not required at the time of proposal submittal but is a requirement prior to the execution of a contract.”

2. Consortium or Joint Bidding

Is consortium or joint bidding allowed under this RFP? If so, are there any specific requirements regarding the structure or documentation for such arrangements?

CUC RESPONSE: Consortia and joint ventures are allowed to submit a proposal. There are no specific requirements regarding the structure for such arrangements. Please refer to page 12 of 31 of the Scope of Work: Section 2.15 Documents Executed Outside CNMI.

3. Proponent Registration Form – Payment Terms

On the Proponent Registration Form, we notice fields for “Terms of Payment” and “Discount Days.” Could you please clarify how these terms are defined in the context of this RFP, and what information should be provided in these fields?

CUC RESPONSE: Proponents should fill out the Proponent Registration Form / Vendor Information Form to the best of their abilities, leaving blank or “N/A” any fields that are not applicable at the time or that are still to be determined.
